Dear Mr. Scott A. McMillan:

This responds to your Public Records Act Request dated December 30, 2020 and received on January 4, 2021. In that request, you made sixty-three (63) separate requests described by you as follows:

Request No. 1. Provide those documents identifying, by date, time and means, all synchronization transmissions between the California Secretary of State and the county Registrar of Voters.

Response No. 1: There are no records responsive to this request.

Request No. 2: Provide those documents with the results of each synchronization transmission between the California Secretary of State and the county Registrar of Voters, by number of registrants confirmed as valid, and those that are identified as invalid.

Response No. 2: There are no records responsive to this request.

Request No. 3: Provide those documents which reflect notifications from the Secretary of State requesting or directing modifications to a voter's registration record between September 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020.

Response No. 3: The Registrar of Voters is in the process of reviewing and collecting for potential disclosure those documents that may be responsive to this request.

Request No. 4: Provide those documents that reflect, in summary form, the modifications to the voter registration record, by date, time, and by any unique voter registration number or name of voter, for those records modified between September 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020.

Response No. 4: The Registrar of Voters is in the process of reviewing and collecting for potential disclosure those documents that may be responsive to this request. Your application for voter registration information has been received and is currently under review.

Request No. 5: Provide those documents identifying where, by geographic location, ballots were counted in the County between October 15, 2020, through November 30, 2020.

Response No. 5: The Registrar of Voters has identified responsive records, which will be made available for review or duplication.

Request No. 6: Provide those documents, i.e., logs, narratives of inspection, created between September 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020 reflecting "Active management (inventory, tracking, and correction) of all software on the network so that only authorized software is installed and can execute" took place in compliance with 2 CCR § 19064(c)(2).

Code. Reg. § 19064.

Request No. 7: Provide those documents, i.e., logs, narratives of inspection, created between September 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020 reflecting "active management (tracking, reporting, and correction) of the security configuration of laptops, servers, and workstations in order to prevent attackers from exploiting vulnerable services and settings" took place in compliance with 2 CCR § 19064(c)(3).

Response No. 7: The county utilizes tools for the management (tracking, reporting, and correction) of the security configuration of laptops, servers, and workstations in order to prevent attackers from exploiting vulnerable services and settings". Request No. 11: Provide those documents, i.e., logs, narratives of inspection, created between September 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020 reflecting the inventory and identification of all wireless connections in the County's ballot processing location.

If you wish to dispute any of the determinations contained in this response to your request(s) please advise us of your legal argument. If you would also please provide us with a citation or legal authority which supports your argument we will be willing to reconsider our opinion.
