This office represents Amador County in regards to the above-reference public records request dated January 21, 2021 and addressed to Kimberly L. Grady, Registrar of Voters for Amador County. Your 15-page request letter contains 63 separate request for records, with some requests containing no date range limitation.

Due to the scope and breadth of your request, the County requires an extension of time to identify responsive records to your request as permitted in Government Code section 6253(c). The extension of time is warranted for the following reasons:

- the need to search for and collect the requested records from field facilities or other establishments that are separate from the office processing the request; and
- the need to search for, collect, and appropriately examine a voluminous amount of separate and distinct records that are demanded in a single request.
